Some tips

Location

So you've got your car, now you need a location. You need to ensure that the car is the centre of attention. Decide whether you want to shoot the car in a natural setting.

Lighting

Next step is lighting, the essential element of every photo shoot! Depending on your location and timing, it's best to use natural light if possible.

Angles

So having set your car up in a great location and figured out the lighting, consider how you want to portray the car, whether there are any features that you want to highlight and therefore what angle to shoot from.

Tips

Windows open, stops reflection, turn the front wheels on to a slight lock, gives action to the picture, look for objects you don't want in the picture, litter, cleaning clothes, people, strong reflections, glare etc..

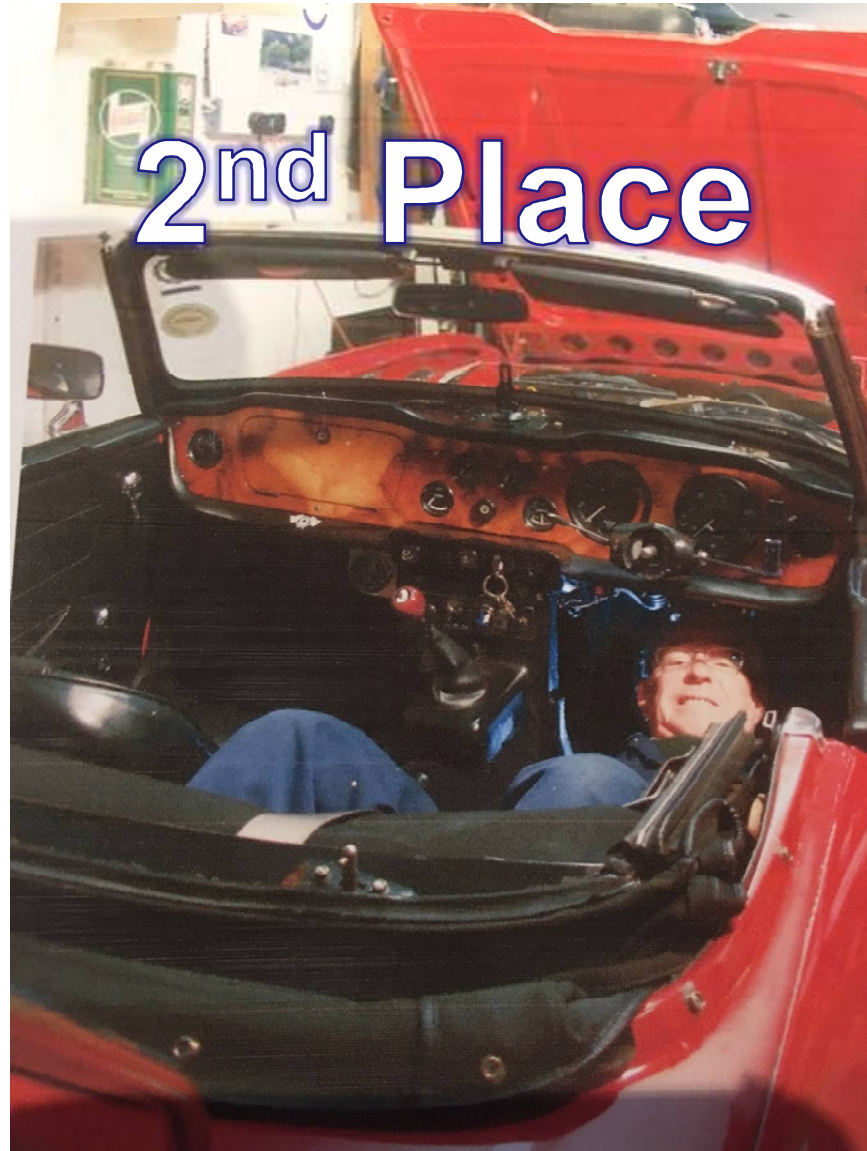
