- Again a Very Active KVG Year

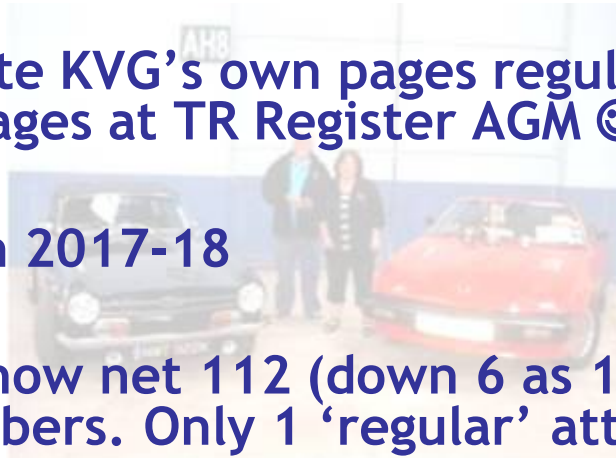

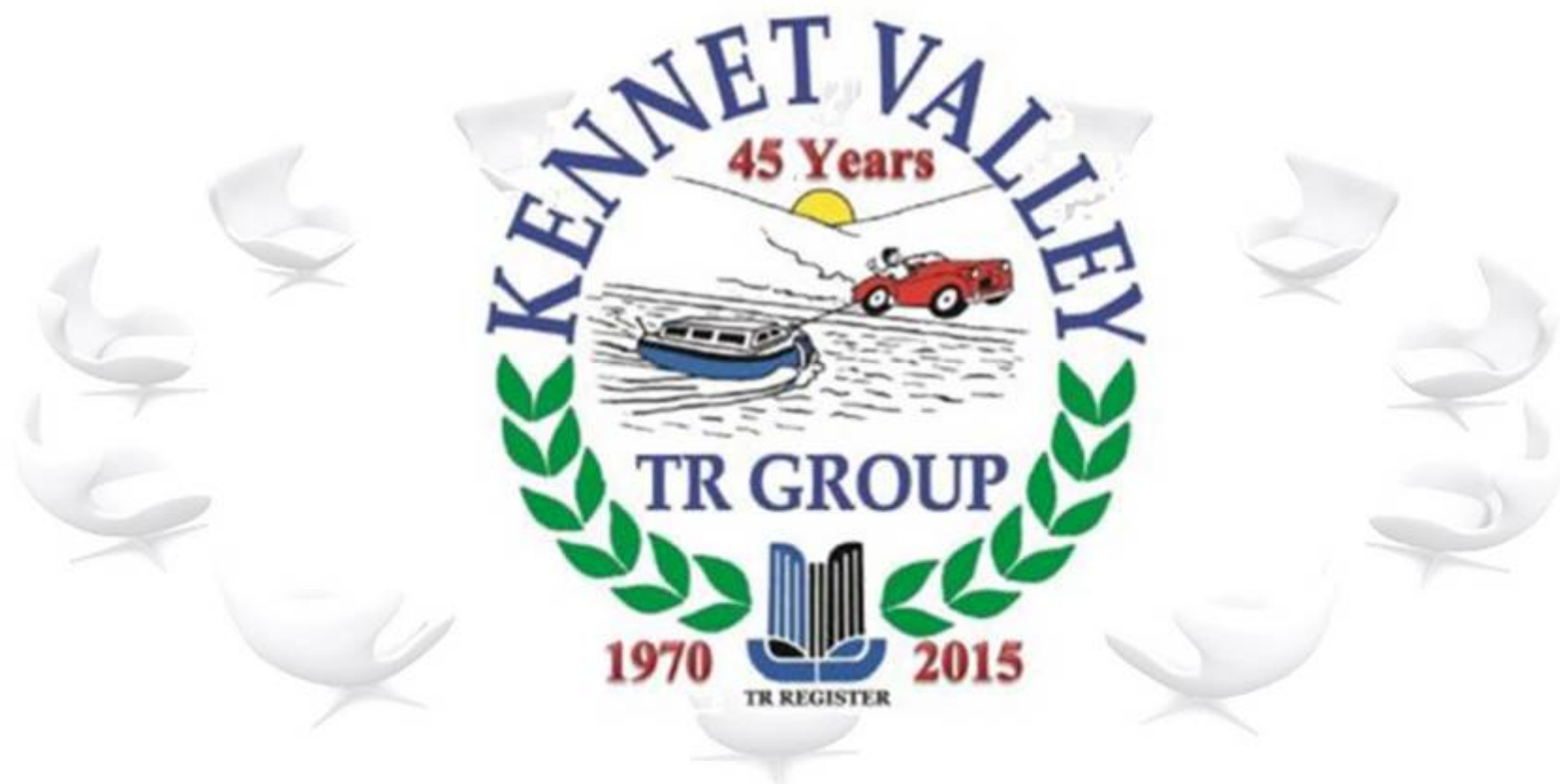
