13:00	Depart Trevor and scenic drive to Hawarden Castle
13:45	Arrive Hawarden Castle for a walk around the grounds including the ruins of the medieval castle.
15.00	Lunch at the Glynne Arms immediately outside the Castle.

This run is intended to coincide with the daffodils and this year we will be visiting Hawarden Castle near Flint which is a private estate having an open day on March 15th.
