Membership

- Average meeting attendance for Jan - Dec 2019
- Total visits 313 / 12 = 26 members average.
- If we include Jan Feb this year, and exclude Jan Feb 2019 - i.e. go Mar 2019 to Feb 2020 it changes quite dramatically, as Jan & Feb were poorly attended.
- The total drops to 286 / 12 = 23.84 members average.
- Membership Numbers - last report 2019 we had 105 Full + 23 Family = 128.
- Membership numbers - latest report to Feb 2020 we have 98 Full + 21 Family = 119.

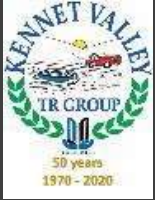
