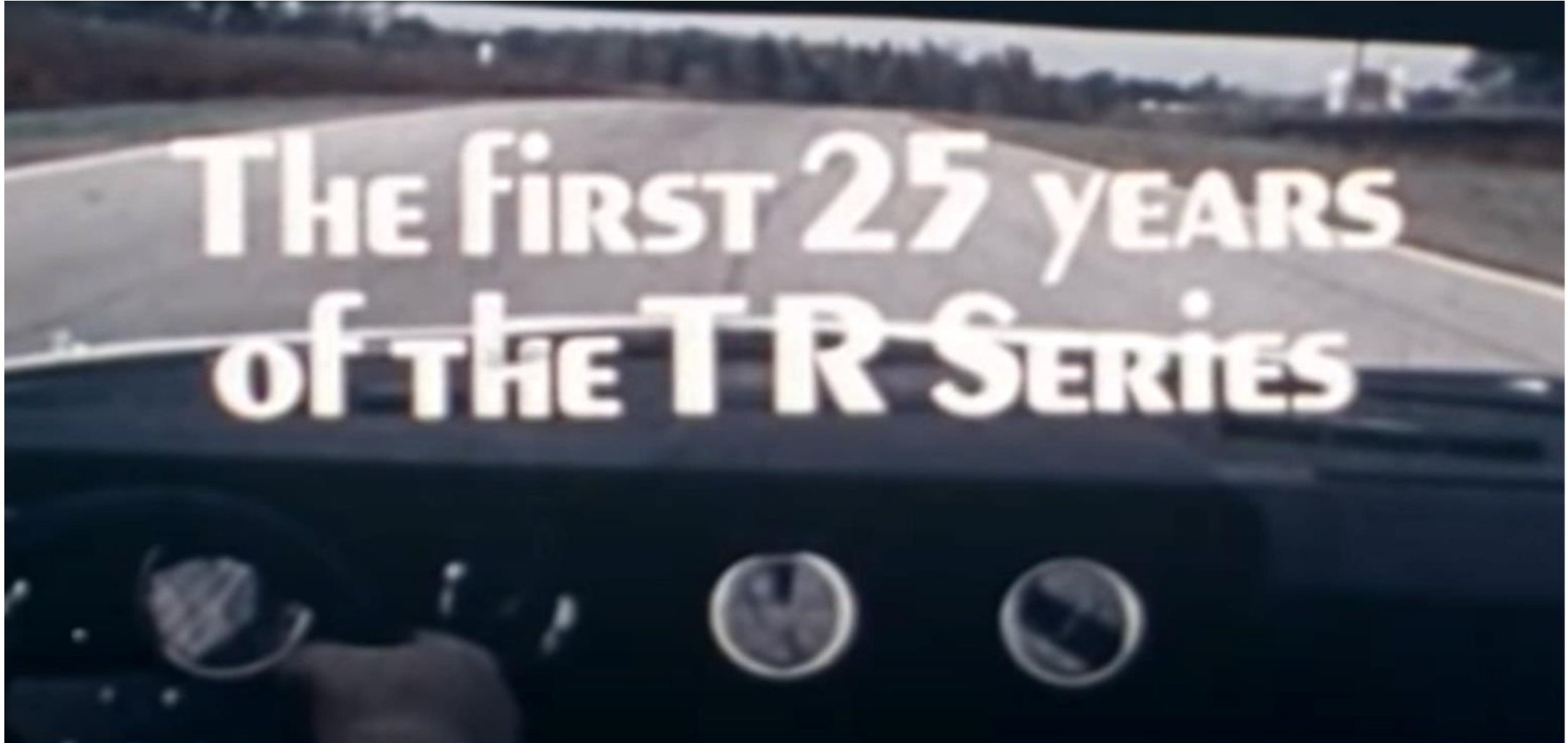

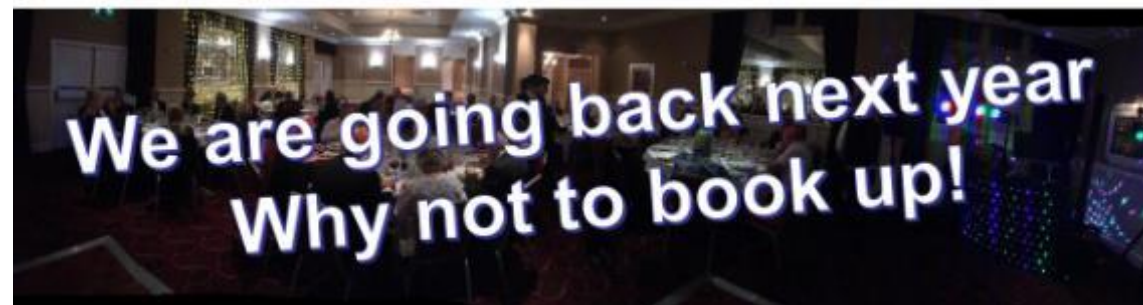
'No Where is far in a TR!'

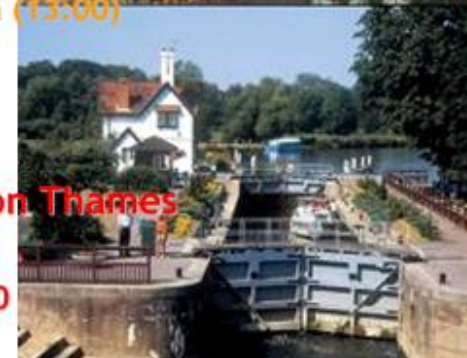
