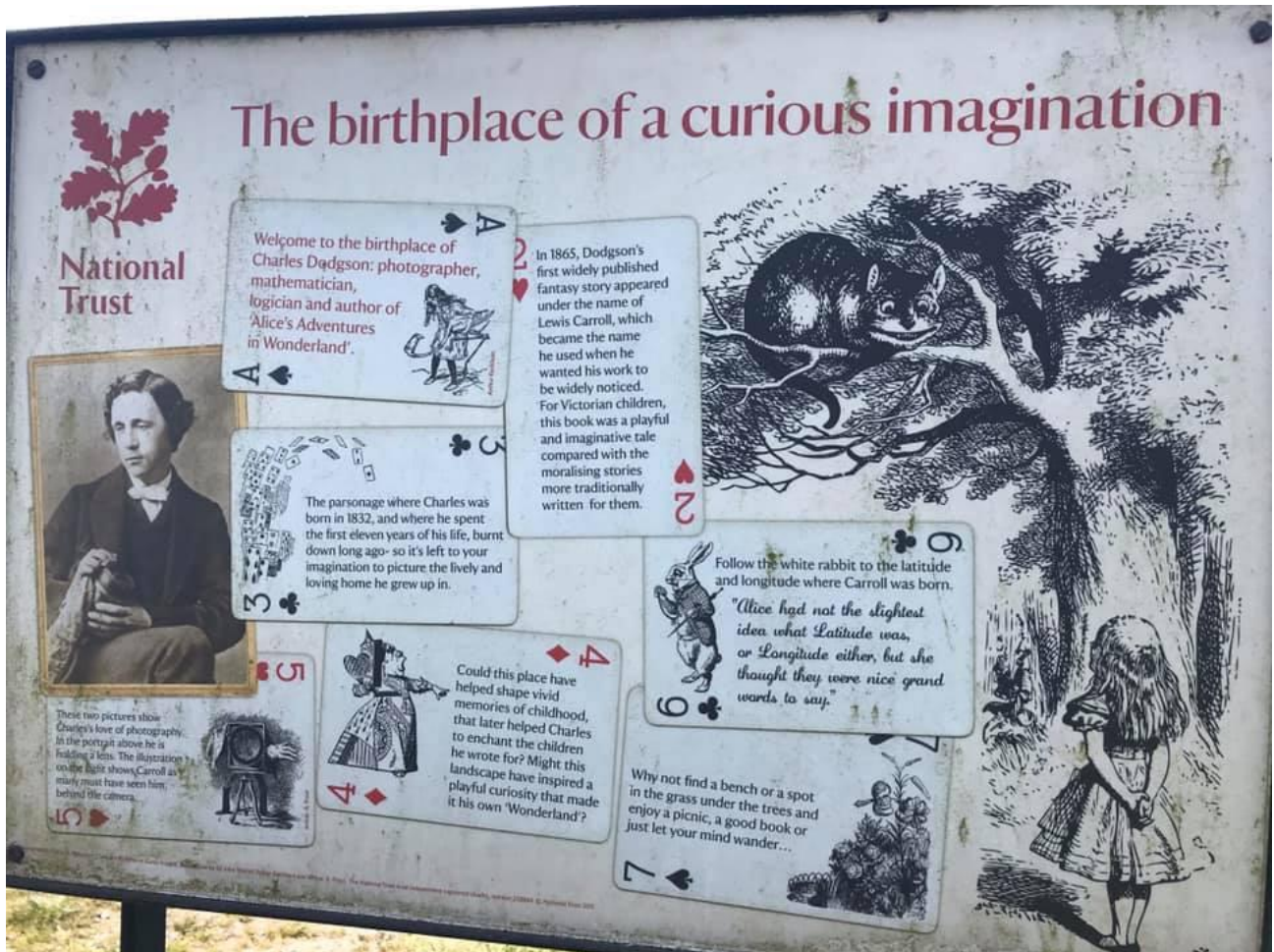
After the run there was a chance for a good catch up over lunch at The Wagon and Horses which I am told is well worth a visit
