MG & Triumph Weekend 13th - 15th August

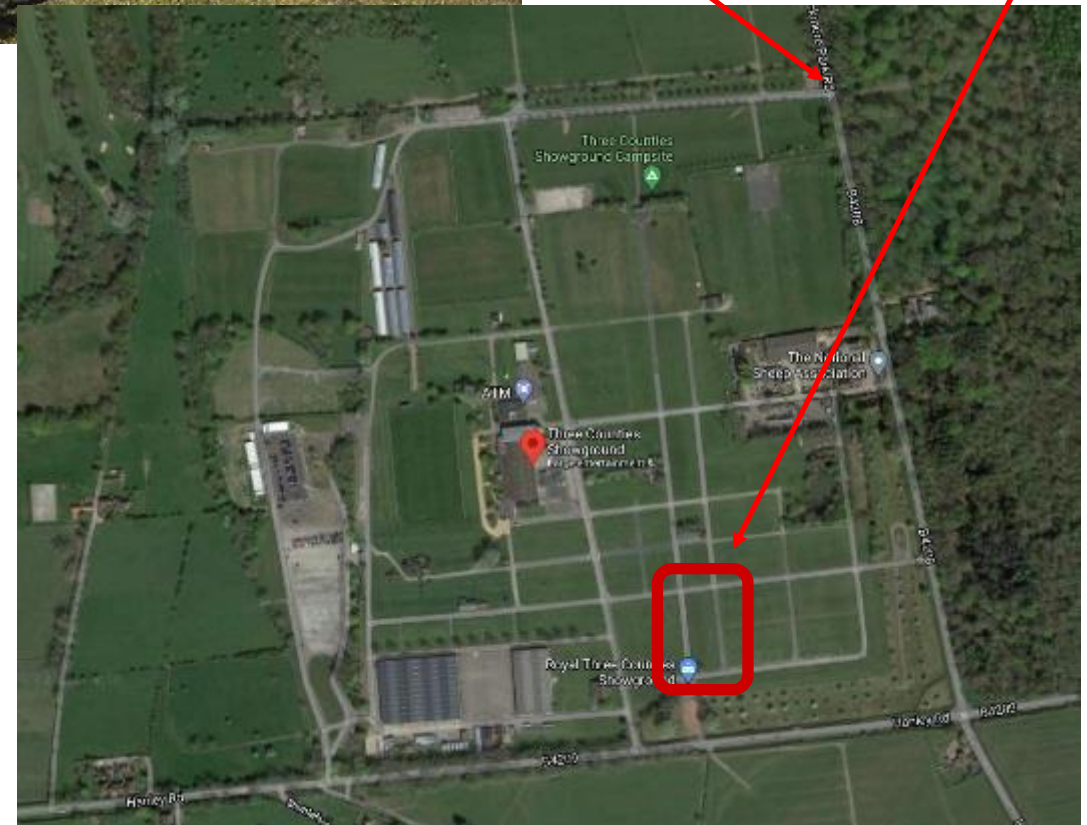

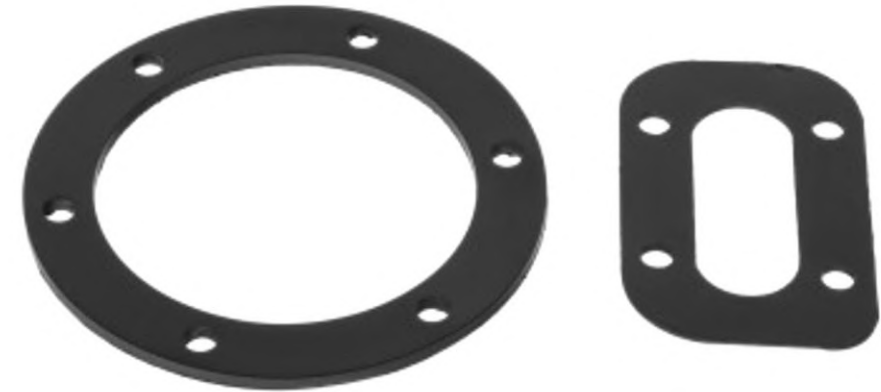

Kennet Valley Group Technical Update

- Paul Woodham has written into me, 'Some of our members might be interested in a kit that Moss sell to ethanol proof the fuel gauge sender unit, as most BMC/Leyland cars use the same gasket this kit will cover most tank gauge units.'
- The normal gasket is made of cork, that I am told can be eaten away by the ethanol, the kit is Viton and has both gaskets, if yours has a top plate as well.
- Moss number is **293-401**, £4.50, a small price to pay to save a boot full of fuel.
- Thanks Paul great tip and timely as last weekend I got a strong smell of petrol in the boot and guess what, yep, the tank sender seal was leaking around the cork gasket.
